Before you Choose

Before choosing a style that's right for you, you should consider these factors:

Degree and frequencies of hearing loss

Not all styles are appropriate for all hearing losses.

Functionality

If special features, such as directional microphones, are required, a smaller hearing aid will not be large enough to house this feature.

Ear anatomy

Some ear canals are very tiny, making it almost impossible to fit a CIC.

Lifestyle needs

If you enjoy being outdoors, you may require a different aid than someone who enjoys the symphony.

Manual dexterity

ITC and CIC hearing aids are easy to insert but require steady hands.

Cosmetic preferences

With the range of sizes, styles and colors available, it is simply a matter of choosing what you prefer.

Cost

Hearing aids are available in a wide range of prices, so there's something for every budget



TIP : It is extremely important to keep your ear moulds and domes free of wax. A loss of clarity in hearing will occur when there is wax build up on the wax guards which protect wax from entering hearing aids, tubing or receivers. Wax is damaging to hearing aids. So please be vigilant and wipe your hearing aids when you remove them from your ears and keep aware of wax build up in your ears and use wax removal drops if necessary. Also, please make sure your ears are free of wax buildup before having a hearing test.

For Australian Government Hearing aid clients

Please note: A Return Voucher Request is an application to have your hearing re-tested.

By now, all clients who were last issued with a voucher for a full free hearing assessment two years ago should have received a document called a *Return Voucher Request*. This document indicates that clients are due for a further free hearing assessment. Please complete and sign this application if you would like a further hearing test. If you decide not to avail yourself of this free hearing test, please contact us and we will explain how the new procedure works and who to contact, if you require further testing. It is important to have your hearing checked on a regular basis. In this connection, it is imperative that clients keep us informed of any change of address.
